AGENDA ITEM 3 – Approve minutes of 1-25-21, as circulated – Trustee Caramanidis noticed an error in the attendance portion of the minutes. Correction made to add Trustee Yeager as having attended. It was stated that Northeast Asphalt came in at \$132,669.00. The additional bid items included the mill and overlay from Fern Drive/Midway Street to Hwy 26. Holdridge explained the options. President Ciske explained reasonings on why no curb and gutter on the lower section of Fern Drive.

Jim Warmbier asked how many years do we have before the Village would put curb and gutter in the rest of Fern Drive? President Ciske stated he wasn't not sure. Jim Warmbier asked about driveway approach and curb/gutter, asking how will you make it match. President Ciske stated that there are no plans at the moment to install curb and gutter at this time and will address if/when it would be needed.

Jeremy Giebel asked who is losing two trees on their property? Public Works Director Dan Holdridge stated that the Zimmerman property has two trees close to the road. Jeremy Giebel also stated that \$132 is an expensive science project. President Ciske explained reasonings for the project due to cost of project.

Trustees Caramanidis/Crook made a motion to approve the base bid amount of \$132,669.00 plus the added \$24,014.40 for Midway plus a contingency of \$10K if needed. Motion was carried by a 6-0-1 roll call. Trustee Yeager was absent for the meeting.
